



Summary of student safety survey 2011

During Term 2 of this year the College conducted a safety survey of students from Year 5 to Year 12. The following is a summary of this survey:

98.6% of our students feel safe in our college

75% report no one is bullying them or making them feel unsafe. (Of the 25% who have been bullied or felt unsafe 60% had reported this incident to a teacher.)

Greater than 99% report that there's at least one adult they could talk to about safety issues at school

No areas on either campus were identified as areas students would avoid because of bullying/harassment issues or because of lack of supervision
